REMINDERS

- Annual Flu Vaccination programme permission slips should be returned to school by TUESDAY 29TH SEPTEMBER. The vaccination programme has been running for a number of years now and has nothing to do with the current pandemic. Please remember that it is your choice whether your child receives the vaccination. Please return the slip to let the School Nurse know whether you agree or disagree.
- **School Questionnaire Survey Monkey -** We askyou all to give us your views on how your child has settled into school. The link for the survey will be live until FRIDAY 2.10.20.
 - **Uniform** Please ensure your child is wearing appropriate uniform every day. Jewellery should NOT be worn apart from stud earrings and a watch. Hair should be TIED BACK.
- **Money -** Any money sent to school should be in an envelope with your child's name/class /purpose on the front.
- **NUT FREE SCHOOL** Our school is completely NUT FREE. Please do not send any products containing nuts/traces of nuts.
- **HEALTHY BREAK** Children should bring a bread, fruit or vegetable based item for break. In line with recommendations from Dental Health professionals no sweet products including sweet yoghurt. This is to help to give teeth a break from acid between breakfast and lunch.
 - **SCHOOL LUNCHES** Everything is going well with lunch arrangements. All children eat in their class bubbles. It is important that you send in lunch money at the beginning of the week as we do not have a credit facility with the lunch provider.
- **FREE SCHOOL MEALS** Please ensure you get your application in as soon as possible. School dinners are expensive!
