CARPARK

Can we please remind everyone of the basic guidelines to keeping safe in the carpark

- DO NOT park on yellow lines at front of school. This area should be kept free at all times.
- **DO NOT** park in the disabled bays unless you have serious mobility issues and cannot walk to the gate. These spaces should be kept free for those who have difficulty walking.
- **DO NOT** park on the corner at the gate or the corner of the grass area in front of the school.
- **DO NOT** double park at the front of the school. Staff try to park at the far side to enable double parking in that area. It is not safe to do this anywhere else.
- DO NOT be offended if you are asked to move. Staff are working hard to ensure we are consistent with all drivers.

Remember the leisure centre is only a 2-minute walk. Please come prepared for unpredictable weather. Every family in our school and schools across NI face issues with school car parking. Apologies for all the DO NOTS but we have to be clear about safety and fairness to all.
